With financial support from the State of California, College Futures Foundation, The Kresge Foundation, and The James Irvine Foundation, the CSU Student Success Network creates spaces and provides resources for people in all levels of the CSU system in support of increasing graduation rates, equity-based inquiry and action, and closing critical opportunity and outcomes gaps. The obstacles to success in higher education are more pronounced for students from low-income backgrounds, students of color, and students who are the first in their generation to attend college– demographic groups that together represent a large proportion of CSU students and the state's population.

There are many student success efforts underway at every level in the CSU to support educational opportunities and close opportunity and outcomes gaps.
